- We see a YMCA Exeter extending its work across the northern half of Devon, with operations in Exeter, East, Mid and North Devon reaching out to rural communities.
- We see a YMCA Exeter that is recognised by the public and local authorities in Devon for delivering high quality services to young people.
- We see a financially sustainable YMCA Exeter with a wide range of income sources.
- We see a YMCA Exeter that partners with, resources, serves and strengthens local churches.
- We see YMCA Exeter that maximises the opportunities for young people through building effective partnerships with key agencies.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The Strategic Plan 2017-2020 sets out our vision of what we wish YMCA Exeter to look like in three years' time. YMCA Exeter comprises of City of Exeter YMCA Housing Association and YMCA Exeter Community Projects, which work together and share resources to maximise effectiveness and efficiency.
- 1.2. Our Christian ethos is the foundation and inspiration for all that we do, and therefore our Strategic Objectives seek to be more than simply about organisational development; through them we seek to demonstrate the love of Christ to those around us, and to be more effective at serving our communities in his name.
- 1.3. Three key statements have been used to inform our decision making as we have developed this Strategic Plan, and we have used these to test the legitimacy of proposed strategic objectives:
- The Vision of the YMCA Federation in England and Wales: "Our Vision is of an inclusive Christian movement transforming communities so that all young people can belong, contribute and thrive".
- The Vision of YMCA Exeter: "To see communities transformed into places characterised by love, joy, peace and hope where all young people can become everything they were created to be".
- The Mission of YMCA Exeter: "To demonstrate Christ's love through practical service that empowers young people and their communities to flourish".

2. STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

- 2.1. YMCA Exeter is part of the YMCA Federation in England and Wales, and we wish to play our part fully in the national Federation. Therefore our Objectives will support at least one of the following national YMCA goals:

At heart, YMCA is a young people's charity and all our projects will have a clearly articulated rationale on how they benefit young people. We define young people as children and young adults aged under 30.

Community Approach

Communities can be groups of people with a shared interest, a geographical location or residents of a project. Supportive and empowering communities provide the best context for young people to truly belong, contribute and thrive. All our work will have a core element of creating supportive and empowering communities.

Spirituality

We will ensure that our work and life as a team remains centred on the example of Jesus Christ, and we will help others explore the spiritual dimension of their lives.


